Classroom Rules

In order to have a safe environment at our center we **enforce** the following rules. Please abide by them at all times to keep the children safe!

Clothing

Children should come to our facility comfortably dressed and in washable play clothes. Because your child will be playing outside as well as using water, paint, glue, etc., an extra change of clothing should be provided to the school at all times. **Boots, sandals (that do not have straps become a safety hazard to the children) and crocs are not allowed.** Coats, jackets, sweaters, caps, blankets and all other clothing or items that are likely to be lost or misplaced must be labeled clearly with the child's first and last initial name with ink.

Toys

We strongly urge parents to discourage their children from bringing toys and other items except on scheduled show and tell day. We try to provide the children with games, art projects, and books. Books are always welcome, because we will be able to share with the rest of the class. Children may bring a special blanket or stuffed animal to sleep with during nap time. Make sure they are labeled, durable and washable.

Fast food

If your child arrives before 8:00, you may provide them with a nutritional home-made breakfast. No fast food is allowed unless it is brought in a disposable container that does not show the logo.

Sign In and Out

It is essential that **you sign your children in at the beginning of the day and out at the end of either their half day, or at the end of a full day.** We strictly enforce these rules for your child's safety.
